December 2016 Summary:

Moderate to strong breezes transported bands of low level clouds across St. Vincent and the Grenadines and brought partly cloudy to occasionally cloudy skies with showers on most days. A few trough systems also added monthly accumulated to the rainfall. At the E. T Joshua station, 220.1 mm was recorded with 20 rain days* and 11 dry days count. Highest total monthly recorded rainfall of 424.3mm was in the Dallaway area. On December 6th an earthquake occurred southwest of Tobago and was felt in SVG. In addition, on December 16th, a high surf advisory and

(Figure 1. Stations- Rainfall (mm))small craft warning were issued. The **highest wind gust** recorded at the E.T Joshua Airport was 30 knots ($\sim 55 \text{km/h}$) on the 22 nd December. **Sea swells** were generally moderate to rough in open waters.



National Rainfall Outlook:

January - March 2017: Above-normal to normal rainfall forecasted. (See figure 2.)

Temperature Outlook:

Air Temperature- Above normal to normal Sea Surface Temperature- 0.5°C above average.

On average, January receives 132.2mm of rainfall(using E.T Joshua Airport 1981-2010 period average). The average maximum temperature is 30.0° C and the average minimum temperature is 21.3° C. Precautions against strong winds, rough seas and high surf should be taken.
